

SUBMISSION AGREEMENT

The QUT Law & Justice Journal (QUTLJJ) invites contributions from staff, practitioners, legal scholars, justice professionals and students on a range of topical issues relevant to both the law and justice fields. Whilst international submissions are welcome, the QUTLJJ reserves the right to reject articles with little or no relevance to our readership.

Contributions must be original works which have neither been previously published nor submitted to, and currently under consideration by, another publication. If the article is submitted to another journal, subsequent to its submission to the QUTLJJ, the author will immediately advise the QUTLJJ Business Manager who will withdraw the article from consideration by the QUTLJJ. Contributions will not be considered unless a signed copy of this Agreement is attached.

The QUT Law & Justice Journal is published twice a year. The QUTLJJ is a scholarly refereed journal. All articles are refereed by at least one appropriate external referee who is independent of the Editorial Board.

Contributions to this Journal should be made in accordance with the QUTLJJ Style Guide. It is the author's responsibility to ensure that their contribution is submitted in, and complies with, the format set out in the Style Guide. When I submit my article for consideration by the QUTLJJ, I agree that:

Acceptance of the decision of the editorial board of QUTLJJ

1. I will accept the outcome of decisions made to publish or not publish my article in the QUTLJJ.

Originality

2. The article I am submitting to the QUTLJJ is an original work which does not infringe the copyright of any other author.

Submission and publication

3. The article I am submitting to the QUTLJJ has not been;
 - Submitted to any other journal for publication;
 - Published by any other journal in this form;
 - Deposited in a self-archive or open archive, such as an 'e-print' database;
 - Published in part. For example it does not contain a substantial portion of the article published in any other form, including material included in journals, chapters or parts of chapters of books, submissions to government, or other sources, unless the material is cited and referenced in the normal academic manner.

4. If I submit the article to another journal while it is under consideration by the QUTLJJ, I will immediately notify the QUTLJJ Business Manager, and the article will be withdrawn from publication consideration by the QUTLJJ.
5. If the article is accepted for publication in the QUTLJJ, my article will be published according to the publication schedule of QUTLJJ. I will not withdraw my article from QUTLJJ if the publication of my article is delayed.

Style

6. I will ensure that my contribution to the QUTLJJ conforms to the QUTLJJ Style Guide, which adopts the citation methods used by the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation* 2nd ed, subject to the exceptions made public by the QUTLJJ.

Copyright

7. I will retain the copyright in the content of the article I submit to the QUTLJJ.
8. I license QUT to publish the article in print form, and in electronic forms that may be accessed through the host site of the QUTLJJ and other electronic means of access used by the QUTLJJ from time to time, including the Australian Legal Information Institute and other national and international organisations.
9. I grant a licence to QUT to exercise all rights relating to the publication and distribution of the print or electronic form of the article.
- 10.1 I accept and understand that QUT has the copyright in the published edition of the journal. I understand that this means that I am not entitled to reproduce the physical appearance of my published article as it appears in either the print or electronic form of the QUTLJJ.

For example, if the author is approached to allow the reproduction of the article as it appears in the QUTLJJ, the author must refer the person making the request to the Business Manager of the QUTLJJ.

- 10.2 After publication by QUTLJJ, if I want to upload my article on my personal server or my institution's self-archive database, such as an e-print deposit, I agree that I must create a link to the electronic form of the article as it appears in QUTLJJ, accompanied by the following text added:

‘The original article has been published in the *QUT Law and Justice Journal* <year, issue number, page number>. The article as it appears at that site is the only authorised version of this article. The copyright in the print and electronic appearance of the article are held by QUT and the copyright in the content of the article is held by the author.’

Republication

- 11 QUT accepts that I have the right to authorise the use of the content of my article in other publications on the following basis excluding **commercial republication**¹:
 - 11.1 The publication of the article in QUTLJJ must be acknowledged;
 - 11.2 The Business Manager of the QUTLJJ must be notified;
 - 11.3 I understand that this right does not include the right to reproduce the physical appearance of the article as it appears in either print or electronic form of the QUTLJJ.

This situation applies if the author is approached to allow the reproduction of the content of the article.

¹ **Commercial republication** includes the inclusion of the content of the article in a cases and materials book.

- 12 I accept that requests for commercial republication of the print and electronic appearance of the article will be made to QUT. Commercial republication of the article by QUT will be made with my agreement.

Moral Rights

- 13 I accept editorial changes that are made to my article in order to conform to the style of the QUTLJJ, to correct errors, and to conform to the observations of referees.

QUTLJJ means the QUT Law and Justice Journal published by the Queensland University of Technology.
